### **LOCKER ROOM ETIQUETTE & RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1) Leave the Locker Room as you found it – or even cleaner! If you see garbage – PICK IT UP and dispose of it (try to throw away 2 pieces of garbage every time)!
- 2) If you do NOT rent a Locker in the Locker Room – you should NOT be in the Locker Room! ADULTS without skating contracts should not enter the Locker Room unless they are there on OFFICIAL SKATING BUSINESS. Having skaters’ moms in the locker room INVADES the privacy of other skaters. If you cannot lace your own skates - please put them on with your parents’ assistance outside the Locker Room using the skating benches provided.
- 3) PLEASE respect all skaters. Many older skaters use the locker room for quiet and homework completion in between sessions – avoid loud and unnecessary activity – please consider exiting the locker room if you will disturb them. YOU will be there someday and you will appreciate it.
- 4) The Junior Board will be responsible for reducing CHAOS in the Locker Room – this is their duty – RESPECT them!
- 5) Remember that maintaining the security of your own Locker reduces the likelihood that you might lose something valuable...AVOID tempting others with an ATTRACTIVE NUISANCE (VALUABLES)...LOCK THEM UP!
- 6) Please close the Locker Room Door gently but firmly when you leave the Locker Room to ensure that the lock is activated and belongings are secure. Contact Coach Paul if you encounter problems with the lock so that he can have it serviced quickly!
- 7) You are responsible for attending at least one monthly Locker Room Clean-Up per Contract Year (The dates and assigned Locker Numbers will be posted in the locker room and an e-mail reminder will be sent out the week prior to the Clean-Up). If you cannot attend your assigned Locker Room Date – you may make it up during any of the following 3 Locker Room Clean-ups. If you do not participate in a Locker Room Clean-up during the year – you will LOSE your Locker and your Locker Room Privileges.
- 8) There are consequences if you continue to disrespect the Locker Room: after 3 separate WRITTEN WARNINGS during a single Contract Year, documented by Junior Board Members, you will lose your Locker privileges for a 6 month Period and then must re-apply for a Locker. If a Waiting List exists – you will be placed on it at the time of infraction.  
EXAMPLES of  
WARNINGS:    Witnessed spills of food or beverage that are not cleaned up in a timely fashion (the same day).  
                  Neglecting your personal effects – even after you have been approached by a Junior Board Member and asked to clean them up.  
                  Repeated presence of an unauthorized skater or parent in the locker room on multiple witnessed occasions.  
                  Signing in but NOT participating in a Locker Room Clean-Up.

\*\*\*A 2nd Warning will also include notification of the skater’s parents and coach to ensure that a 3<sup>rd</sup> warning can be avoided\*\*\*
