- 2) Skater is responsible for their own measurements and understands that they are responsible for any size alterations that are needed.
- 3) Costumes **cannot** be returned or exchanged for different sizes. **PLEASE MEASURE CAREFULLY!**
- 4) Costumes may **not** be altered before pictures without approval from the costume committee.
- 5) Costumes must be worn as directed by the costume committee and show director – **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 6) Skaters who are cast as soloists in the show must have their costume approved no later than January 1, 2010. ***Soloists who do not have their costume for picture day will not be pictured in the show program and picture will not be posted at the rink.*** Please plan accordingly.
- 7) Skaters and parents must respect all fellow skaters, volunteers and directors of the ice show. Many hours are spent preparing for an outstanding show that is fun for skaters as well as pleasing to the audience. Please be considerate of others to make it a positive experience for all involved.
