October 2021

- Back2School 2021: The Back2School session ended on 10/16 (6 weeks)

- Fall 2021:. The Fall session starts 10/25 and ends 12/18 (7 weeks) with no Learn2skate the week of 11/22-11/27 due to Thanksgiving.
