Executive Reports:

- 1. Treasurer's Report
 - a) Finances are favorable.
 - b) Freeskate is very close to breaking even, which is a significant improvement from prior years costs.
 - c) TOI and Synchro are self-sustaining.
 - d) Ice Show generated a larger profit than 2017. 3064 people attended the show and it was the highest attended show since the 75th anniversary show.
 - e) Hiawathaland was a success with a \$3500 profit, which is slightly lower than 2017.
- 2. President's Report Highlights from the year:
 - a) Initially we were expecting a budget deficit, but with our increase in sizes in our L2S programs, along with other efforts, we are no longer in a deficit. Credit the team and specifically Maureen, our Director.
 - b) We hired a new LS2 director, Kari Sackett.
 - c) Submitted a bid for TOI Nationals in 2019. Declined due to the committee wanting Nationals back in the South since the last few were Midwest. Will consider future submissions for TOI or other smaller competitions.
 - d) Currently investigating upgrades to our show lighting.
 - e) We were approved by Rec Center Management to design a trophy case to be displayed in the lobby and with approval of that design can build it.
- 3. Election Results
 - Fawn Hangge announced the nominated members voted into the RFSC Board: Elizabeth Rice, Amanda Roe, Darin Tosse
 - b) Recognition of the board members leaving: A. Mikhail, J. Miller, T. Desens, L.J. Engle, Kelly Corbin.
